Communications Committee: Oversees public affairs efforts and provides services and materials to assist the members to communicate information about our industry to policy makers and the public through our website and other communication strategies.

Governmental Affairs Committee: Provides guidance for the activities of the association's advocacy staff and consultants. The committee will be responsible for permitting and land use issues.

Environmental Subcommittee: Involved with legislative and regulatory environmental issues that impact the industry.

Technical Subcommittee: Monitors technical specifications for concrete and aggregate producers and combats unrealistic requirements.

Transportation Policy Subcommittee: Concerned with all new regulatory and legislative issues concerning transportation of goods, trucks, fleets, and licensing.

Taxation Subcommittee: Reviews tax related bills and focuses on tax issues as they relate to the industry. Coordinates seminars for mineral assessors on how to correctly evaluate mining properties.

Legal Action Committee: Will recommend to the Executive Committee legislative, regulatory or administrative actions that need to be taken in response to actions taken by the courts. Reports on recent court decisions and will recommend when and where to involve the industry in litigation, particularly when a legal precedent is at stake.

Member Services Committee: Will coordinate the actions and policies of all subcommittees relating to member services. Proposals for association policy or legislative or regulatory initiatives by any of its subcommittees will be forwarded to this committee for consideration.

Associate Members Subcommittee: Addresses needs of Associate members and nominates the association representative to the Executive Committee and Board of Directors.

Membership Subcommittee: Developing methods and programs to increase association membership. Explore new member services and expand existing services that provide value to membership. Develop methods and materials to recruit and retain members to CalcIMA.

Human Resources Subcommittee: This committee is responsible for reviewing matters of employment, worker's compensation insurance, unemployment insurance, and other human resources issues.

Safety and Health Subcommittee: Reviews enforcement trends, safety practices, regulatory developments, and identifies training opportunities for the membership.

Programs and Meetings Committee: Responsible for the planning and execution of the Board Meeting and its members, Legislative Conference, Annual Education Conference and all other educational programming that includes but is not limited to meetings, conferences, workshops and special events.
