

CalCIMA Participation Form

Education, Events and Membership Services Committee: Make recommendations on programs, policies and services that would enhance and expand the value of CalCIMA membership. Also responsible for developing programs to recruit and retain members. This committee will also be responsible for the planning and execution of meetings, conferences, seminars, workshops and other special events that advance the business and educational goals of CalCIMA. The committee will have both producer and associate members which reflect the scope of membership. These members will select a Chair and Vice Chairs to serve a two-year term.

Environmental & Natural Resources Committee: Involved with state legislation, regulation and administrative actions relative to environmental issues. The committee will coordinate with the Governmental & Legislative Affairs and Legal Action Committees. It will also be responsible for identifying educational and training programs that CalCIMA may conduct through its Education, Events & Member Services Committee. Committee membership is open to all members in good standing. The Chair and Vice Chair must be Producer members and will be nominated by the CalCIMA Chair and approved by the Board of Directors to serve a two year term.

Governmental & Legislative Affairs Committee: Responsible for advancing CalCIMA's strategic interest through state and federal legislation, regulation, and/or administrative action. Activities include, but may not be limited to, reviewing and initiating legislation, monitoring administrative and regulatory initiatives, advising of needed actions, and directing the advocacy staff and consultants. Membership is open to any CalCIMA member in good standing. The Chair and Vice Chair shall be producer members who are nominated by the CalCIMA Chair and approved by the Board of Directors to serve a two year term.

Legal Action Committee: Responsible for advising the Board of Directors on legal actions that need to be taken by the Association, in response to measures taken by the courts or governing bodies at the local, state and federal levels. This includes any and all Association involvement in industry litigation. Committee meets jointly with the Governmental & Legislative Affairs Committee to advice on legislative or regulatory matters as they relate to the drafting and advocacy of CalCIMA legislative initiatives or positions. Membership is open to all CalCIMA attorney members. The Chair shall be a CalCIMA member attorney who will be nominated by the CalCIMA Chair and approved by the Board of Directors to serve a two year term. The Vice Chair of this committee will be the CalCIMA Counsel.

Public Education & Outreach: Responsible for developing programs to enhance the public relations opportunities for our industry to education the general public and local and state policy makers.

Technical Committee: Responsible for promoting and advocating for best industry practices, technical innovation and specifications. It will also strive to protect the industry from adverse decisions by policy makers and regulators. Responsible for working with Caltrans Rock Products Committee and other related industry coalitions. Work closely with the Governmental & Legislative Affairs Committee in reviewing legislation and promoting industry initiatives. Membership will be open to all CalCIMA members in good standing. The Chair and Vice Chair will be Producer Members selected by the committee membership to serve a two-year term.

Transportation Committee: Responsible for reviewing regulatory and legislative issues concerning industry transportation issues. It will also keep members informed on new issues and trends in regard to equipment and technology through educational events and by contributing information to CalCIMA communication vehicles. The committee will be open to any member of CalCIMA in good standing and will select a Producer Chair and Vice Chair to serve a two-year term.

Safety and Health Committee: Review of enforcement trends, safety practices and regulatory developments at both the state and federal level. It will also work closely with the Education, Events & Member Services Committee on identifying opportunism for education and training programs. Membership is open to all members who currently engage in health and safety related issues for their companies. The Chair and Vice Chair of this committee will be Producer Members selected by the committee to serve a two-year term.
