




### Mining in California by County (FY 2022)


Operator Employment in California by County (FY 2022)




### California Operator Miners & Mines (FY 2018-2022)






### Top 10 Mined Materials in California By Employment (FY 2022)

### California Citations and Orders Issued (FY 2018-2022)




Represents all non-vacated citations and orders.

#### Represents 33.5% of All Citations and Orders





## Distribution Of Total Injuries in CY 2022 By Experience



### Distribution Of Total Injuries in CY 2022 By Accident Classification






#### **Fatalities in CY 2022**
